ACCOMMODATION

Camping is in the main field and your space is included within the price. Those in tents usually camp in circles; those in camper vans probably in a line along the hedge. Water-stand pipes are onsite and there will be a plentiful supply of firewood.

There is also hostel (dormitory) accommodation in the Village Hall and in the Quaker Retreat Centre (both within a five minute walk of the main field). Each has kitchen and bathroom facilities. For these there is an extra charge.

THE SITE

Cumbria Circle Dance Camp is held on private land in Rusland, Nr Ulverston.

The main field, bordered by a stream, houses a beautiful geodesic dome with a wooden floor for all the main dancing. It has its own Stone Circle. Also here are the camping circles, the café and kitchen.

Along the stream, thro the woods are the showers which have constant hot water. Another woodland path leads to composting toilets. To the South in the trees is the Healing Tent.

Cars are parked offsite, from whence a path leads down and thro' a field to a small marquee for other dancing, singing and music.

CAFÉ

The café cooks fresh food daily for lunch and supper. Vegetarian, vegan and carnivore options are available. Teas, coffee, hot chocolate, cold drinks, cakes and biscuits served all day.

Any very special diets will be catered for, if given sufficient notice.
